As a group, we respond to medical aids, traffic collisions, and mutual aid requests from neighboring towns, roadway hazards, technical rope rescue requests, wild land fires, structure fires, and all other emergencies that may occur in our community. Monthly, we have a business meeting on the first Thursday and the following Thursday nights are training drills. Along with all of that, our volunteers participate in community activities like 4th of July fire truck rides, parades, traffic control, and raising/lowering the lights on the largest living Christmas tree in the U.S.
